

A Hospital for the Community

After four years of designing, building, testing and training, the new 136,000 square foot Owatonna Hospital will open its doors at 7 a.m. Friday, Oct. 16, 2009. For nearly 110 years, Owatonna Hospital has provided quality care to people of all ages and with the grand opening, it has a world-class building and technology to match the quality of its care.

The new Owatonna Hospital sits on 20 acres and is located adjacent to Interstate 35. The opening of the new hospital completes the second phase in developing an Owatonna Healthcare Campus on the northwestern edge of Owatonna. The healthcare campus project includes the expansion of the existing Owatonna Clinic facility on 26th Street. The goal is to provide a more responsive health care environment that meets the changing functional, technological and efficiency demands of the future.

The new 2-story hospital is physically connected to the expanded Owatonna Clinic-Mayo Health System, which bridges inpatient and outpatient services within the same medical disciplines to create a seamless approach to patient care throughout the campus.

Allina Hospitals & Clinics committed \$46 million to fund construction, equipment and furnishings. Twenty acres of land donated by the Owatonna Clinic several years ago, was valued at \$2.6 million. The remaining costs of \$3 million helped fund Special Project Features identified by the community in 2006, which include: a Reflection Center, Community Resource Center, Professional Education Center, atrium and enhancements to the Rehab area. The Special Project Features were funded through philanthropic donations by businesses, organizations and individuals.

DESIGN PLANNING

What's unique about this \$51.6 million project is that in 2006 more than 500 community members told the project team what they wanted in their new hospital. Taking their feedback, the new hospital features international best practice in contemporary hospital design including:

- A welcoming, reassuring atmosphere
- Family-friendly patient and visitor facilities
- Respect for privacy, religious and cultural needs
- Appropriate technology
- Electronic medical record
- An advanced work environment that enhances the quality of care provided by staff

New Owatonna Hospital Features

- 3 spacious birthing suites with full, private bathrooms including shower and Jacuzzi tub; TV, DVD player and overnight accommodations
- 7 post-partum rooms with a full, private bathroom including shower and tub, TV, DVD player; overnight accommodations; in-room microwave and refrigerator
- 17 private medical inpatient rooms located on the second floor with private bathroom including shower and tub, and overnight accommodations
- 4 Special Care Unit private patient rooms
- 4 large operating suites equipped with advanced technology and a dedicated C-Section operating suite
- 18 prep/recovery rooms in our Outpatient Surgery area
- 2 endoscopy rooms with enhanced privacy
- 1 laser eye room
- 12 spacious, private emergency treatment rooms with helipad
- 10 beds in the Mental Health Unit with secure outdoor patio
- Electronic medical record, a computerized version of a paper medical record, that allows nurses and physicians to place all care orders electronically, eliminating handwritten and verbal orders

- Community Resource Center for medical condition research, health education classes and respite areas including comfortable couches, large screen TV and fireplace
- Reflection Center to meet families' and patients' spiritual needs
- Professional Education Center providing onsite education for nursing and technical staff
- Onsite retail pharmacy
- Expanded coffee and gift shoppe
